Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Conejo Valley Unified School District (District) is committed to providing equal access to qualified individuals with disabilities in non-educational programs and activities of the District, as well as practicing nondiscrimination in all of its programs and activities; pursuant to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act (1973), each qualified individual with a disability within our schools, regardless of the nature or severity of the individual's disability.
