

NOTICE TO PARENTS

This District is committed to providing equal access to qualified individuals with disabilities in non-educational programs and activities of the District, as well as practicing nondiscrimination in all of its programs and activities, pursuant to Section 504, to each qualified individual with a disability within its jurisdiction, regardless of the nature or severity of the individual's disability. Except for those circumstances where fees are imposed on non-disabled individuals or their parent(s), the District shall make reasonable modifications in policies, practices, or procedures when the modifications are necessary to avoid discrimination on the basis of disability, without cost to the qualified individual with a disability or to his or her parent(s), such as the provision of auxiliary aids or program accessibility. The District is responsible to provide an equal opportunity to qualified individuals with disabilities in non-educational settings includes providing services and activities in such a manner as is necessary to afford qualified individuals with disabilities an equal opportunity for participation in such programs as non-disabled students. Parents and Guardians may file a complaint if they believe a violation of federal law and/or of the District's regulations and policies have occurred.
